

Medication policy for parents / carers



Visit to doctor

Always bring an up-to-date medication overview with you when visiting a doctor. In this way, the doctor has an overview of the medication use.

Medication change

Ask the doctor to always report all medication changes (start, dose change, stop, etc.) in writing, so that the pharmacy and nursing staff can provide a good administration list. Or write this down clearly in a notebook yourself. Have the prescription with the medication change or for a new medication sent directly to the Farmadam pharmacy. Contact details pharmacy:

Do you need occasional acute medication immediately?

Does your child need a medicine immediately (such as an acute course of antibiotics) outside the opening hours of De Waggelmannetjes, or when your child is staying at home? Pay attention:

- Ask the prescribing doctor to send the prescription once to the on-call pharmacy or pharmacy of your preference, so that you can collect the medicine from the pharmacy of your preference.
- For this it is very important that you give the pharmacy, along with your preference or the pharmacy on duty, permission to share the medication data with other pharmacists via the Landelijk Schakelpunt (LSP). Farmadam can adjust the medication administration lists with the data from the LSP, so that they remain up to date for the Waggelmannetjes and for the home nurses
- Ask the pharmacy with your preference to notify Farmadam of the delivery. He can then adjust the administration list for the nursing staff of De Waggelmannetjes.
- Always notify the home nurses and nurses of De Waggelmannetjes at the start of the care for your child or earlier.

Please note: Contact between parents and pharmacy is always through De Waggelmannetjes, not directly with the pharmacy, unless a prescription has been sent to Farmadam and you would like the prescription to be sent to the pharmacy of your preference.

Collecting medication

If you have a prescription sent to pharmacy Farmadam, they will provide a new administration list for the nursing staff of De Waggelmannetjes and home nurses. With the prescription, Farmadam will, if necessary, also ensure the delivery of the medication on, depending on the time, the same day or the next working day.

Medication without a prescription

Over-the-counter medications can affect how other medicines work. Always report the use of non-prescription medication, supplements, homeopathic remedies, etc. to the care of De Waggelmannetjes. They will discuss with you what to do.
